The resource consists of a 1939 Parker Through Truss bridge with a concrete deck covered with asphalt and a concrete curb. A cantilevered sidewalk is located along the southeast side. Stone and concrete abutments are located on either end of the river. Two				
stone piers from a previous bridge and a concrete pier support the bridge span across the river. The bridge appears to retain its				
original riveted connections. A Works Progress Administration (WPA) stamp with the date 1940 is stamped on the bridges wingwall.

NRHP Evaluation GAI Consultants, January 2019

The resource is recommended not eligible under Criterion A due to a lack of significant association with an important historic transportation system, program, event, trend, or policy identified through a historical context. Although a WPA stamp is present, the year does not coincide with the mandufacturer's date. No record of a WPA project in Ivydale was discovered. While the bridge is named for former State Representative, J.C. Cruikshank from Ivydale, the bridge lacks a direct association with Cruikshank or any other historically significant individuals. As such, the resource is recommended not eligible under Criterion B. However, the bridge retains the historic integrity necessary to convey its engineering and design significance. Due to this significance, the building has been previously determined eligible for the NRHP under Criterion C and maintains integrity to remain eligible.
