Raised one story, one bay, gable end to street plan with belfry over front entrance. Side bay windows are arched casement windows with fanlight. Basic form of church is intact. Modern exterior materials of siding and aluminum shed roof side entry overhang does not effect the integrity of this building.

HISTORICAL/CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE

The Quinnimont Missionary Baptist Church is maintained by the community residents, and is one of two churches serving the Quinnimont area. It is owned by the National Park Service, along with four former residences in the town.
