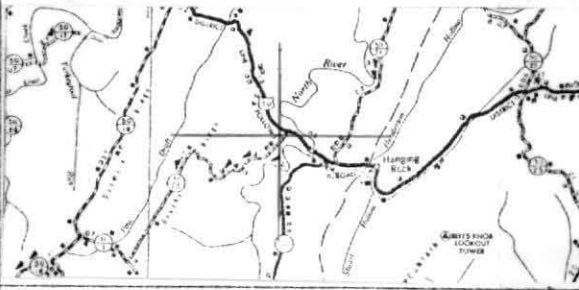
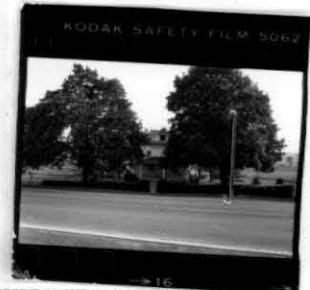

	STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE	Based on the physical structure: late Victorian-era detailing is unusual in the country houses of the area. The deck is a feature found in a few Greek Revival buildings of the 1830s and 1840s in this section, but not seen elsewhere.
