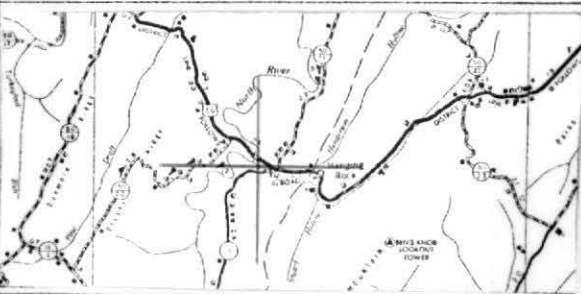
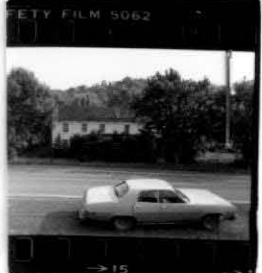

It was apparently constructed in two sections, for a vertical seam is evident and cornice bracketing (in pairs) is along only one part. Windows are 6/6, and there is a porch across much of the front.

	STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE	Based on the physical structure: the building may be part log. The long, narrow shape is a common design in this area. The paired cornice brackets are unusual.
