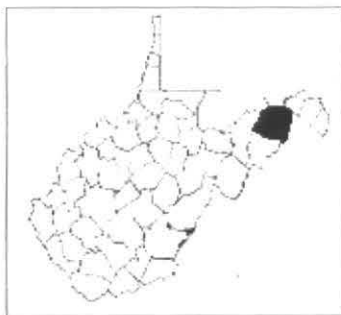

Fenestration incorporates 6/6 windows along with 4-light eyebrow windows above a hipped-roof screened-in porch on the façade. Gable-roofed ell at the rear. One gable end is finished in metal board-and-batten sheets.

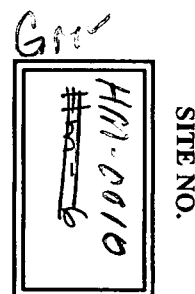

Is significant as a preserved, intact example of early 19th century log construction and the rural working family. Also significant for having been the home place, since 1865, of the locally important Scanlon family. The property is most significant, however, for having been the boyhood and family home of Dr. Charles Scanlon, nationally and internationally known leader of the Temperance Movement.
