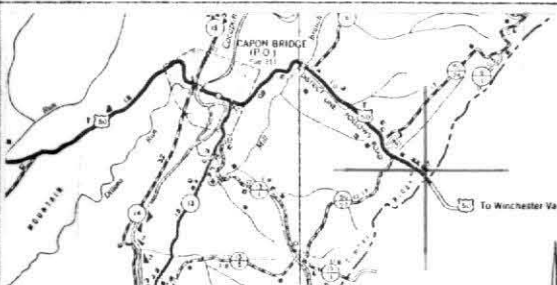

A brick chimney that pierces the roof ridge may be original, but a narrow brick chimney on one end was added. There are long porches across both front and rear.
