The house consists of a c. 1790 section of stone and a c. 1900 frame unit. Each is two stories, and interior end chimneys serve fireplaces in the stone section. Gable roofs are at each end of the T-shaped building, porches are around the frame part and on the front and one side of the stone section, windows are of various styles (6/9, 9/1, 6/1, diamond shaped) and the frame unit is sided with shingles. There is a log barn and a small log outbuilding on the property.

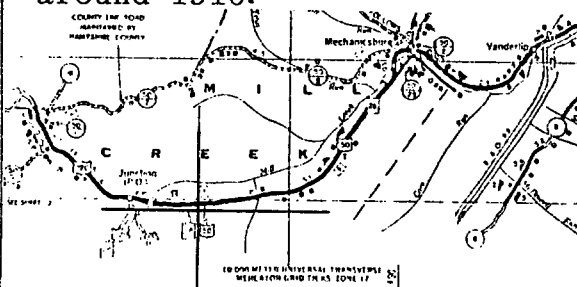

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The house was built for Richard Sloan and his wife about 1790. They soon developed a weaving industry centered around their lands and continued the family trade until 1854. Three Parker brothers purchased the house and land then, and it has continued as a farm since. The house was ransacked by Federal troops during the Civil War. It served as a stage stop on the Northwestern Turnpike from mid-19th century until the railroad came to the area
