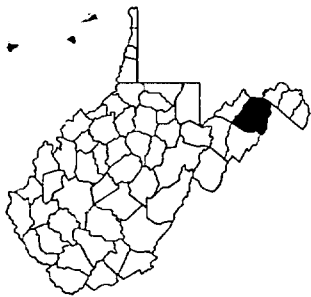

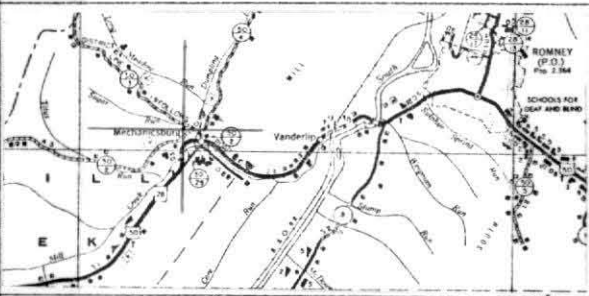

	STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE	Based on the physical structure: the ell shape with a hipped roof where the units connect is seen only infrequently. The stone end chimneys are sizable.
