Reference materials indicate that during the War Between the States, this was the home of Dr. Lupton and was referred to as the S.R. Lupton Home Place. An advertisement appeared on the front page of the South Branch Intelligencer, on September 28, 1860, providing the public with Dr. S.R. Lupton's references and indicates he was a physician and a surgeon.

The large T-shaped home adjoins the property of the West Virginia Schools for the Deaf and Blind. Two stories high with decorative cut work added under the eaves, gothic arches incorporated into the sidelights and delicate lattice work on the one bay front porch combined with the notoriety of an early resident provide the significance.
