



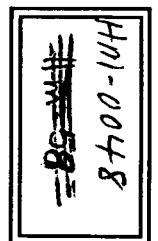

Brick church 3 bays wide by 6 bays long, with one bay in the rear running perpendicular to the main building. There are three round stained glass windows on the front. Very fine detail and craftsmanship in the brickwork and windows.

HISTORICAL/CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE

The congregation was organized about 1782. The present church was built around 1860. During the Civil War the church was used as a stable and a hospital.
