



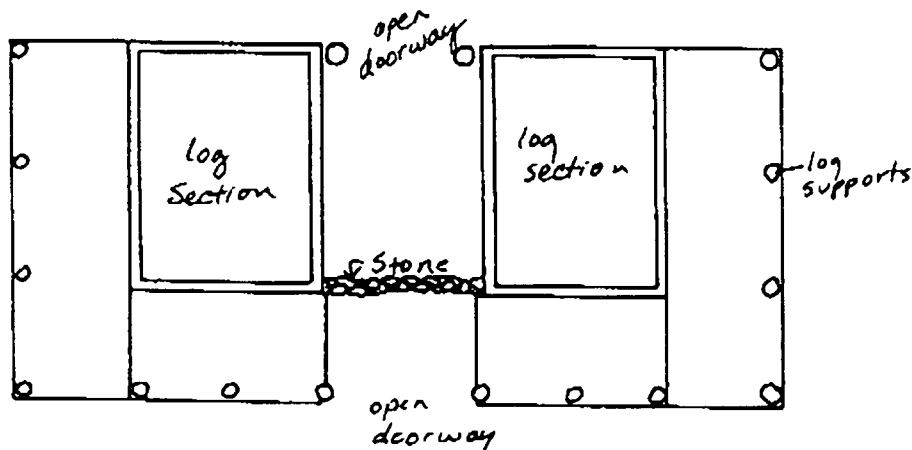

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY (ORIGINAL AND PRESENT)

Structure is a barn of a type called a threshing barn because the central bay is open on both ends. There are two log portions of the barn on either side of the open central bay. Two of the log beams run the length of the barn. The log sections are on stone foundations at the front and back, and on stone piers along their sides. The rest of the structure is build of upright log supports placed in the ground, with planks attached to these. The roof appears to be galvanized metal.

HISTORICAL/CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE

The barn is part of a large farm and is part of the same property as the Hook Tavern, located at the intersection of County Road 6 and Route 50.
