Number and Nature of Outbuildings

There are no outbuildings associated with this resource.

Resource Description

This resource is a one-lane bridge over Mill Creek on Core Run Road, off Highway 50 on the east side. The supports are two reinforced concrete abutments and one reinforced concrete pier. The deck is of wood planks. There is evidence that there was a previous bridge immediately to the south of the current one.

Historical/Cultural Significance

This bridge was not included in the bridge survey done by Emory L. Kemp. It replaced an earlier bridge and could be a modern structure.

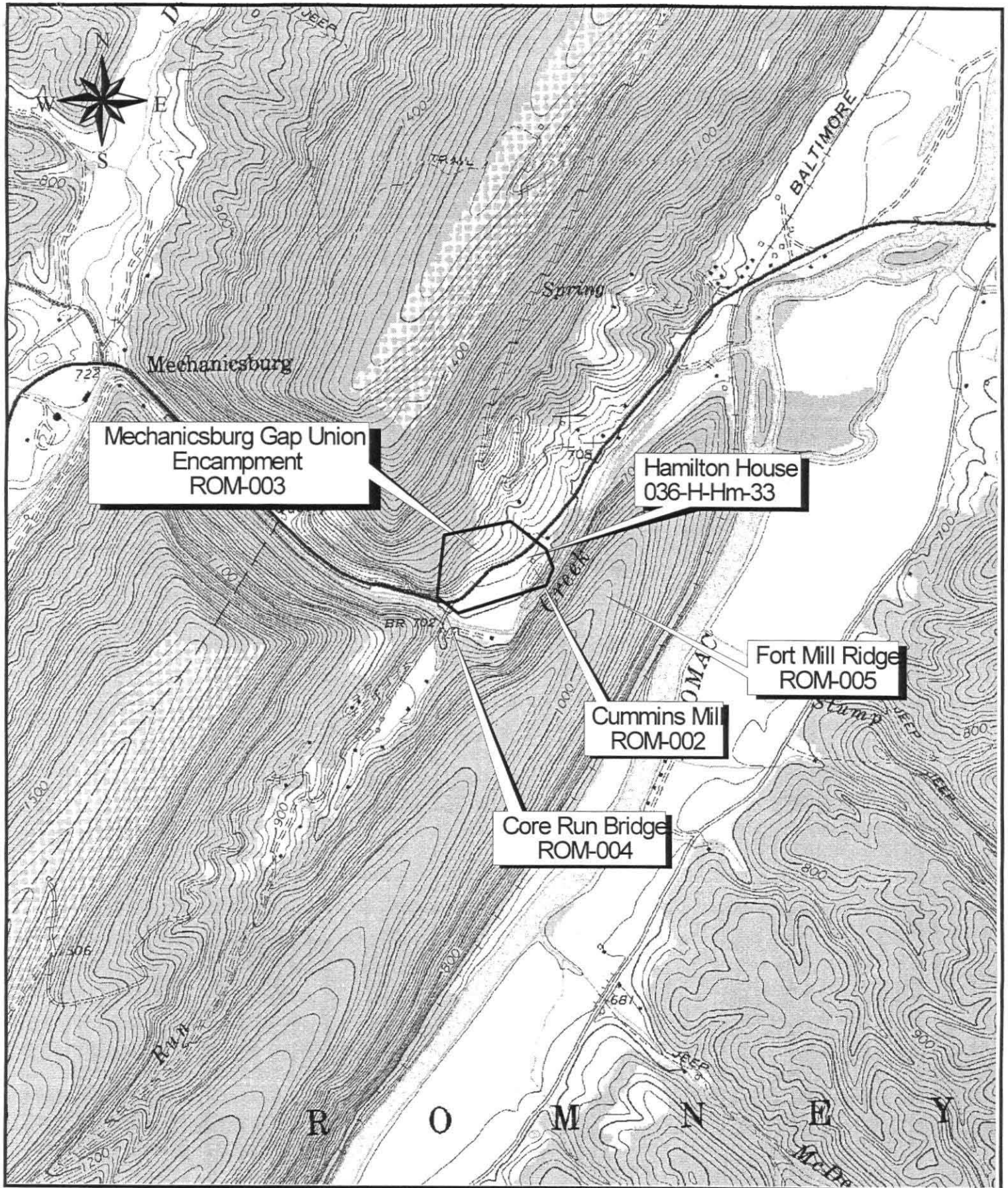
National Register Eligibility Assessment

The resource was evaluated under the Criteria for Evaluation for the National Register of Historic Places. It was found to be *not eligible* because it is not an outstanding example of its type.

The resource does not meet Criterion A because it lacks clear association with any significant historic event or patterns of history, nor does it meet Criterion B, as research has not revealed any association with a significant individual.

The resource does not embody any outstanding bridge design. Therefore it is not eligible under Criterion C.

Historic research has not determined a potential to yield information important to history or prehistory (Criterion D).
