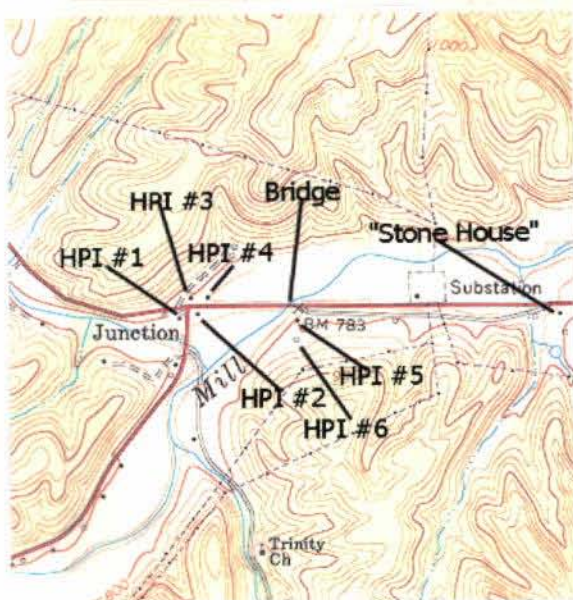

Description of Buildings or Site (Original and Present) Originally built as an "I" house residence, this two-story frame has had extensive modifications and additions. The main addition is a two story two room wide rear rooms under a shed roof. The first floor is a garage/basement and the upper story is divided into two rooms. There is a two story, one bay wide entry covering porch located in the central bay facing US Rt. 220. It is an open gabled and the columns are encased in matching siding and the upper porch is enclosed to the mid wall on three sides. The windows are a mixture of modern replacements and six over one sash wooden double hung original units.
