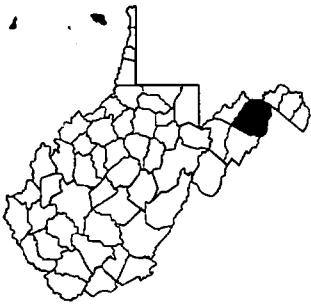


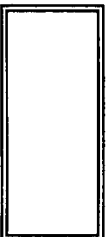

This large brick building dominates much of Main and Grafton Streets. The brickwork is very fine and executed in Flemish bond with glazed headers. Ionic brick pilasters divide the front facade into three separate business units. A similar treatment is used to define bays on the Grafton Street side. The front entrance is topped by a Palladian-style window and flanked by stone pilasters. The cornice is now absent its original modillion blocks.
