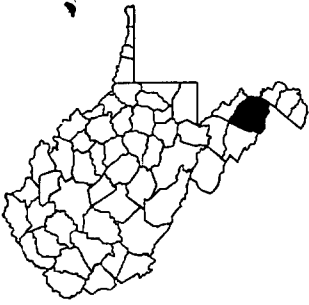
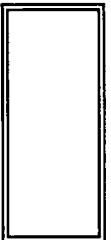

The street level's large plate glass commercial windows and recessed splayed entrance are protected by a pressed metal pent roof with chevron details.
