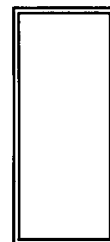

This commercial building is constructed with bricks laid up in a 5:1 common bond pattern. The roof-line is accented with a 3/4-width parapet. The lower commercial front is altered, but in a manner somewhat sympathetic with the original tripartite design. With respect to second level fenestration, both openings feature a double-brick segmental arch and brick sill. One of the original 2/2 windows has been changed to a 2/1 configuration. A round, oculus window is centered on the facade immediately beneath the parapet. The brickwork, especially in the upper level, needs repair.

This narrow, 2-story, commercial building is constructed with bricks laid up in a 5:1 common bond pattern. The roofline is accented with a $\frac{3}{4}$ -width parapet. The lower commercial front is altered, but in a manner somewhat sympathetic with the original tripartite design. With respect to second level fenestration, both openings feature a double-brick segmental arch and brick sill. One of the original 2/2 windows has been changed to a 2/1 configuration. A round, oculus window is centered on the façade immediately beneath the parapet. The brickwork, especially in the upper level, needs repair. Despite some alterations and deterioration, it remains an important contributing resource to the Historic District.
