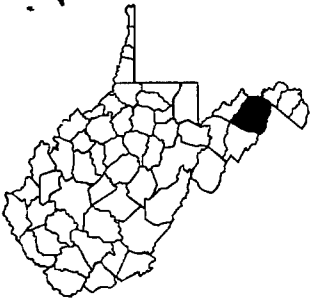
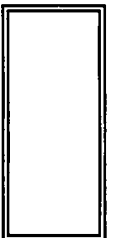

This asymmetrical commercial duplex presents itself as a separate building. It is, however, both physically and legally attached to the neighboring 2-story structure located at the intersection of West Main and Marsham Streets. A seam between the two buildings indicates they were conceived as separate entities. The front wall features five courses of brick stretchers, alternating with a single row of alternating headers and stretchers. The facade is dominated by large, plate-glass commercial windows and recessed, aluminum-and-glass doors. The side and rear walls are constructed in concrete block. Its massing and scale are relatively consistent with Main Street.

This plain, 1-story, flat-roofed, brick and concrete-block, asymmetrical commercial duplex presents itself as a separate building. It is, however, both physically and legally attached to the neighboring 2-story structure located at the intersection of West Main and Marsham Streets. A seam between the two buildings indicates they were conceived as separate entities. The front wall features five courses of brick stretchers, alternating with a single row of alternating headers and stretchers. The façade is dominated by large, plate-glass commercial windows and recessed, aluminum-and-glass doors. The side and rear walls are constructed with concrete block. As with several of its neighbors, this building lacks architectural distinction. It is, however, approximately 50 years of age and typical of commercial architecture of that period. Its massing and scale are relatively consistent with Main Street's traditional character and therefore is considered to be a contributing resource.
