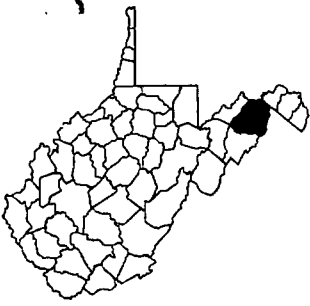

This flat-roofed building dominates its street corner. It is a 2-story version of the building connected on its east side. The two buildings share many similarities and are legally part of the same parcel. The large plate-glass windows and aluminum-and-glass door on the 1st story are protected by an original aluminum canopy. Fenestration in the 2nd story of the Main Street facade consists of three banks of windows, each of which contains four, 1/1 openings. Nine window banks containing the same arrangement are situated on the elevation fronting Marsham. Its massing and scale are consisted with Main Street.

This large, 2-story, brick and concrete-block, flat-roofed commercial building dominates the southeast corner of West Main and Marsham Streets. It is basically a 2-story version of the building connected to its east side. The two buildings share many similarities and are legally part of the same parcel. The large plate-glass windows and aluminum-and-glass door on 1st story are protected by an original aluminum canopy. Fenestration in the 2nd story of the Main Street façade consists of three banks of windows, each of which contains four, 1/1 openings. Nine window banks containing the same arrangement are situated on the elevation fronting Marsham. Like its neighbors, this building lacks architectural distinction. It is, however, approximately 50 years of age and typical of commercial architecture of that period. Its massing and scale are relatively consistent with Main Street's traditional character and therefore is considered to be a contributing resource.
