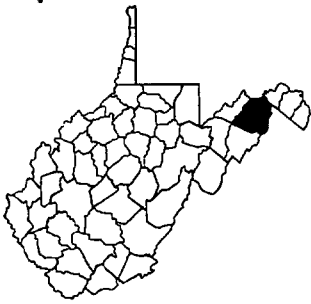

This badly altered, frame building is clad with aluminum siding. It is the only remaining historic building on this side of the block. The facade is dominated by a heavily rebuilt, full-width, porch that completely overhangs the sidewalk below. A second porch exists on the building's west side. All windows and most doors are relatively modern replacements. It appears that the building was constructed as a private residence. The lower level is now a retail concern, while the upper level is used as apartments.

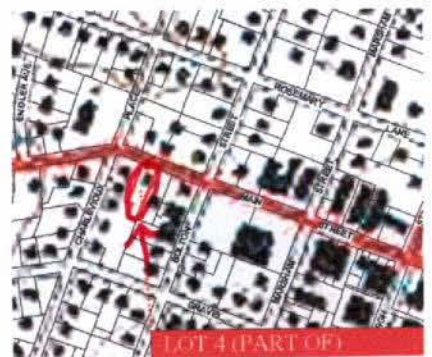

Located on the south side of Main Street and flanked on either side by paved parking area, this badly altered, 2-story, shed-roofed, frame building is clad with aluminum siding. It is the only remaining historic building on this side of the block. The façade is dominated by a heavily rebuilt, full-width, porch that completely overhangs the sidewalk below. A second porch exists on the building's west side. All windows and most doors are relatively modern replacements. It appears that the building was constructed as a private residence. The lower level is now a retail concern, while the upper level is used as apartments. A small, early-20th century frame garage survives in back of the main building. This historic building is altered and lacks individual distinction, but retains enough integrity to warrant inclusion in the Romney Commercial Historic District.
