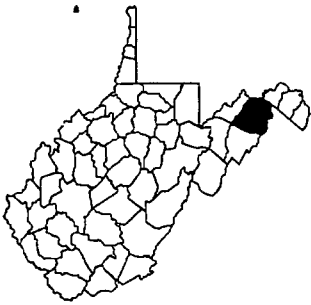


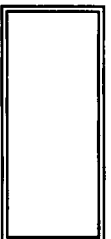

This long, gable-roofed, 2-story building features a brick-veneered first story beneath a vinyl-sided upper level. A hipped-roof pent runs along the front façade and terminates in a vehicle drive-thru on the west wall. Window openings are unevenly spaced and fitted with modern sash. The roof is covered with standing seam metal and pierced left of center at the ridge line by a massive stone chimney. The chimney stack's size and brickwork suggests a historic building(s) is entombed beneath layers of modern materials. It is badly altered, but considered to be a contributing resource due to its appropriate scale, massing, some traditional materials, and restoration potential.
