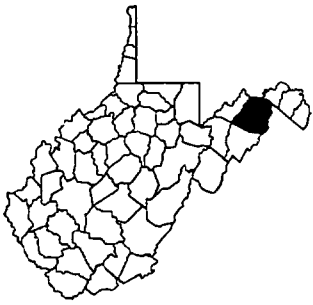


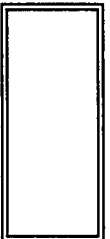

This large, asymmetrical, flat-roofed building features walls laid up in 6:1 common bond brick that is painted white. The foundation is poured concrete. A small parapet and concrete coping distinguish the roofline. The facade is altered. The large 1/1 window located in the building's southwest corner of the facade is a relatively modern replacement. A similarly sized window opening is enclosed. Only one of the three front doors appears to be original. Side walls retain segmental arched openings, fitted 4/4 double-hung sash windows. Ghosting evidence indicates this building may have been constructed as a garage or warehouse. It is now vacant, but recently houses a laundry.

This large asymmetrical, 1-story, flat-roofed, building features walls laid up in 6:1 common bond brick that is painted white. The foundation is poured concrete. A small parapet and concrete coping distinguish the roofline. The façade is altered. The large 1/1 window located in the building's southwest corner of the façade is a relatively modern replacement. A similarly sized widow opening is enclosed. Only one of the three front doors appears to be original. Side walls retain segmental arched openings, fitted 4/4 double-hung sash windows. Ghosting evidence indicates this building may have been constructed as a garage or warehouse. It is now vacant, but recently housed a laundry. This historic commercial building lacks architectural distinction, but it retains a fair degree of integrity and helps to anchor the east end of the Historic District, and therefore is considered a contributing resource.
