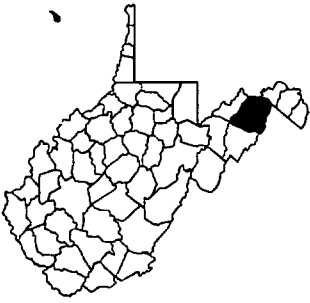


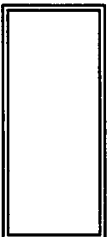

This gable-front, running-bond brick building rests on a slab foundation. It sits on a narrow lot and has dimensions typical of several other small businesses. Earl's Barber Shop is a small, narrow, 1-story, gable-front, running-bond brick building with walls resting on a slab foundation. It sits on a narrow lot and has dimensions typical of several other smaller businesses. It is the last commercial building on this side of the street and its lot represents a boundary of the Historic District. The eaves of the low-pitch roof are boxed. The upper gables display vinyl siding and a small vent area. The right-side entry is fitted with a wood-and-glass door. It is accessed by two small concrete steps. A large, plate-glass window is located on the left side of the entrance. This modern building does not contribute to the Romney Commercial Historic District.
