Miller's Market is not shown on the 1973 USGS map which indicates its construction post-dates this document. Located in a parking lot behind (south) of the Rite Aid, this large, rectangular, vaguely Colonial Revival style, brick grocery store has large plate glass windows along its front (north) façade. A disproportionately small cupola is situated at the roof's ridgeline. The roof overhangs to provide a protected loading/unloading area. The entrance is distinguished by a wide pedimented portico. It is the last commercial building on this side of the block. Traveling south from Miller's Market, the area becomes residential. This modern building does not contribute to the Romney Commercial Historic District.
