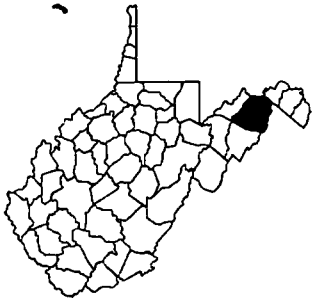

This gable front building has a low-pitch, gable roof with slightly overhanging eaves and a boxed orifice. An external concrete block chimney stack is located toward the rear (east) of the building. The form of this building suggests it was constructed as a dwelling, but it is presently used for retail purposes.

This walls of this small, 1-story, gable-front, 3-bay frame building are sheathed in vinyl siding and rest on a concrete-slab foundation. The low-pitch gable roof has slightly overhanging eaves and a boxed cornice. An external concrete block chimney stack is located toward the rear (east) of the building. Three steps lead up to the centrally placed entrance. The entrance opening contains a modern metal and glass door and flanking 1/1 widows. The form of this building suggests it was constructed as a dwelling, but it is presently used for retail purposes. Its lot is one of the District's southern boundaries. All of the buildings south of 72 Marsham Street were designed for domestic use. This building does not contribute to the Romney Commercial Historic District.
