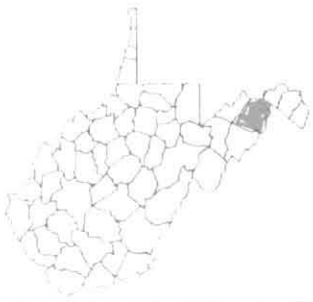

Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) 1 Stories ___1___ Front Bays Front entry adorned with dentil molding above the door and four-light transom; 6/6 double hung sash on left and right faces. Working shutters. Glazing is original. Metal roof with snow birds Cemetery fenced with paling, well maintained, with easy access. Site was an early gathering place for settlers. Oldest graves are unmarked in the lawn and driveway. Settlers, slaves, and veterans of the American Revolution and American Civil War, both CSA and USA. Burials include Samuel Hook and his two wives.
