Describe Setting Church sits on a small knoll along CR 13 in front of a large cemetery, both enclosed with paling fence. ~3 ____ Acres ____ Artifacts Present					
Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) 1 Stories 3 Front Bays Gable front building with center hall. Six over six double hung sashes with working shutters and heavy wooden lintels and sills. An additional three-light Gothic window centers the gable peak. Ogee cornice on the left and right faces. Brick corbelling on the façade. Plain glass panes allow a view of the oak pews and carved appointments within the fairly small church. Though Greek Revivals were not as common after 1860, this building features several architectural elements appropriate to the style. Small one story rear extension. Cemetery features burials that predate the construction of the church, suggesting that there may have been an older building on the site. The congregation was established in 1812. More than 1,300 burials. Oriented se/nw. Earliest burial is 1850, suggesting the earlier presence of another church building.
