Description of Building or Site (Original and Present) 2 Stories ___4___ Front Bays This is a log house that rests on large stones as a foundation. 2/2 and 6/6 double hung sash. Entry is left of center with a replacement door that has half lights. Rear extension with shed roof. Front portico is hipped metal with bold entablature supported by four chamfered wooden posts. Steeply pitched roof is accented with a wide frieze at the junction of roof and wall. Full two stories tall. Asymmetry of the bays suggests the house may have been built in two stages, with the left portion being the original. Deep window reveals. <i>(Use Continuation Sheets)</i>
