Pyramidal roof, center front walled dormer with hipped roof. Center hall American Foursquare house, bold corner boards and window trim. Some replacement 1/1 double hung sash and some original sash windows. Original façade windows feature smaller upper sash and large lower sash. Hipped front porch roof with snow birds, supported by square tapering posts. Internal brick chimney. The house was designed by a descendant of the original settler. She included much architectural detail in the building, including a stylized screen door that still survives. She oriented the house to the four points of the compass. (Use Continuation Sheets)
