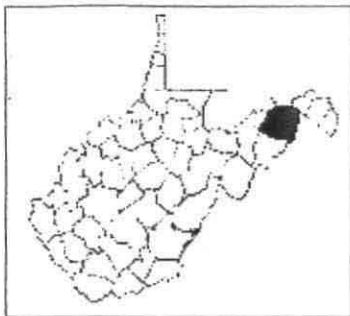

1-story Gothic Revival-style church of wood construction, with a gable roof and gable-end orientation to the street, with a forward-projecting entry bay capped with an open belfry. The belfry incorporates a balustrade around the bell, a pyramidal roof, and a pinnacle at the peak. Fenestration is flat-topped, with lancet-arched windows finished with religious art glass. The main entrance is centered on the façade, incorporating a doorway capped with a lancet-arched transom, above which is a semi-circular wheel window.
