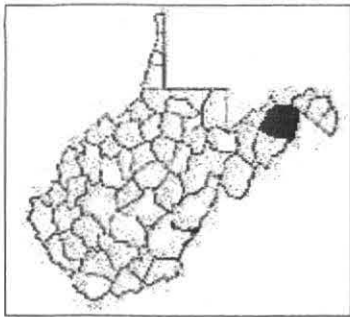

1½-story Dutch Colonial Revival-style cottage of wood construction with a gambrel roof and gable-end orientation, with a raised hipped-roof porch extending across the façade with replacement supports and balustrade; centered entrance on the 3-bay first story and a pediment of the gable which incorporates paired windows. Fenestration is flat topped, with 3/1 and 1/1 sash. An enclosed back porch is at the rear.
