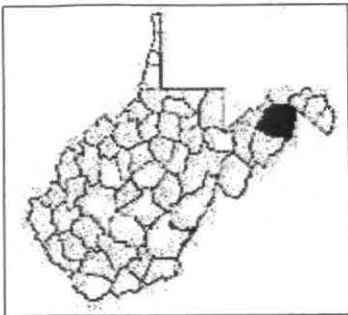

First floor is finished in asbestos shingles, and a centered entry is on the façade, capped with what appears to be a brick soldier course lintel.
