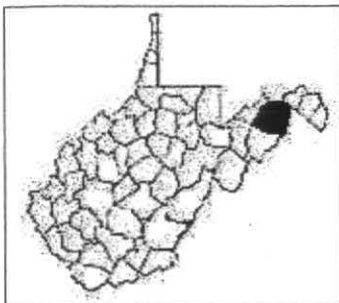

2-story vernacular residence of wood construction, with an intersecting gable roof system and a 1-story hipped-roof porch extending across the façade and wrapping around a portion of the side elevation. The porch is supported by replacement turned wood posts. On the side elevation is a 1-story oriel window. Fenestration is flat topped, without notable ornament, and appears to incorporate replacement sash.
