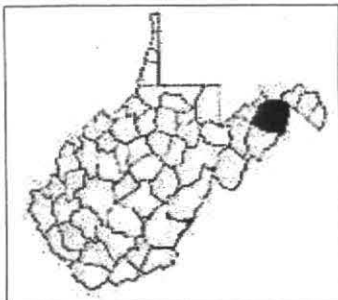

2-story l-house of wood construction with a side gable roof and a 3-bay façade with a centered entrance on the first floor, shielded by a full shed-roofed porch which is supported by plain wood posts. The main entrance is centered on the façade, featuring a single doorway. Fenestration is flat topped, 6/6, with what appeared to be exterior fixed shutters. The porch is enclosed within a sawn wood balustrade. (Use Continuation Sheets)
