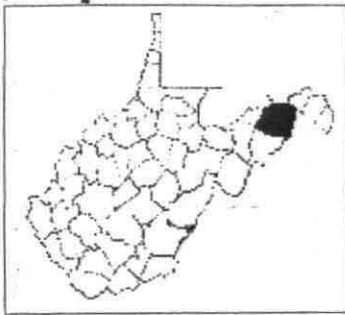

2-story vernacular I-house of wood construction, finished in red insul-brick, with a side-gable roof and rearward-projecting ell, along with what appears to be an enclosed back porch. First story façade is 3 bays in width with a centered entrance, shielded by a shed-roofed porch supported by wrought iron replacement posts. Upper façade is 2 bays in width. Exterior gable-end concrete block furnace chimney, and a non-historic wood deck on the side elevation.
