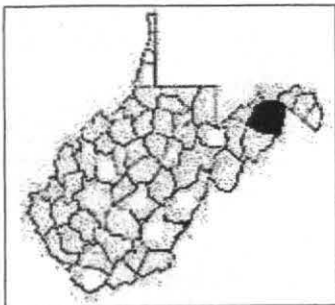

1½-story vernacular cottage of concrete block construction, with a side gable roof and a centered shed dormer on the façade, with 2 small windows and exposed rafter tails. Side gables are finished in asbestos shingles. The roof extends beyond the plain of the building and is supported by a series of 4 wood posts. Fenestration is flat topped, 1/1, along with a 3-unit window on the right side of the façade.
