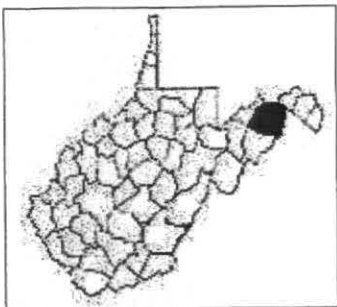

1½-story vernacular cottage of wood construction, with a gable roof and gable-end orientation, incorporating a hipped-roof front porch supported by plain wood posts and enclosed within a replacement wood balustrade. Fenestration is flat topped, including a paired window unit in the pediment of the gable on the façade. Red brick chimney penetrates the slope of the roof.
