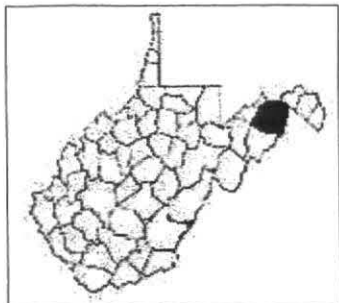

Statement of Significance:	
Higginsville is a former stagecoach stop on the route between Cumberland, Maryland and Winchester, Virginia, once known as the Cumberland Road, later Slanesville Pike. This barn may date to the stagecoach days, but its National Register eligibility would have to be confirmed with an inspection of the condition of the interior and with the concurrence of the SHPO.
