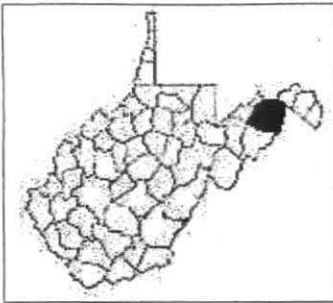

This house is located along a rural county road in central Hampshire County.

2-story residential building, vacant and abandoned, in a state of deterioration. The building is of wood construction, finished in the original German siding and weatherboard, with an intersecting gable roof and a full hipped-roof front porch, supported by turned wood posts. The building is L-shaped in plan, with a hipped-roof side porch and 2-story bay window in the angle of the ell. Fenestration is flat topped, 2/2, with decorative window heads not seen elsewhere within the survey area.
