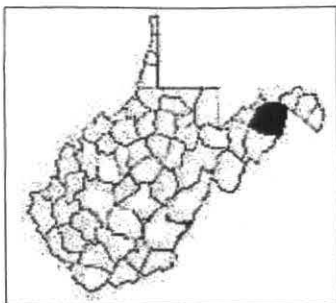

2-story L-shaped vernacular building which appears to have been a commercial property along with residential, with the remnants of the storefront on the first floor. In the angle of the ell is an addition with a front porch, and a double-gallery porch is on the façade, with the second story enclosed and penetrated by 6/6 windows. Exterior surfaces are finished in insul-brick, and a red brick chimney penetrates the roofline.
