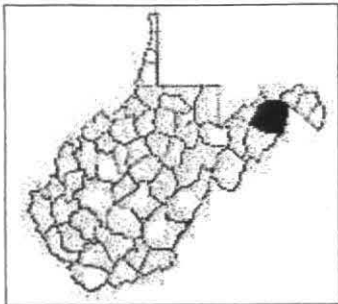

2-story Colonial Revival-style residence of wood construction, with a pyramidal roof penetrated on the façade by a gable dormer within which is a Palladian window. Fenestration is flat topped, with multi-light replacement sash. Extending across the façade is a substantial veranda, with an enclosed section which occupies much of the left side of the property.
