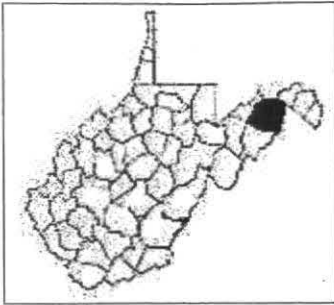

This house is located along a rural county road in central Hampshire County, west of Town Hill and south of the unincorporated village of Levels.

2 Stories 4 Front Bays	
2-story vernacular residence of wood construction, whose façade incorporates 3 bays on the first story and 2 bays above. Side-gable roof with interior gable-end red brick chimneys. Fenestration is flat topped, with 2/2 and 1/1 sash. Extending across the façade is a hipped-roof porch, supported by plain wood posts, which extends beyond 1 gable end to be incorporated into an addition.
