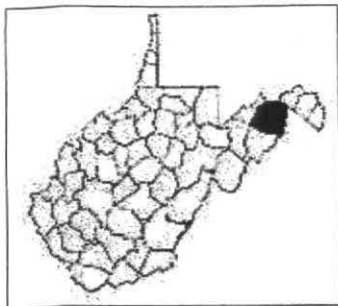

Statement of Significance:	
The village of Levels was originally known as Levels Cross Roads because of its location at the intersection of four roads in north-central Hampshire County: Bright's Hollow Road (County Route 5/5) north to Okonoko, Little Cacapon-Levels Road (County Route 3/3) southeast to Slanesville, Jersey Mountain Road (County Route 5) south to Romney, and French Station Road (County Route 5/7) northwest to South Branch Depot. This house has been altered and does not appear to meet National Register Criteria for Evaluation.
