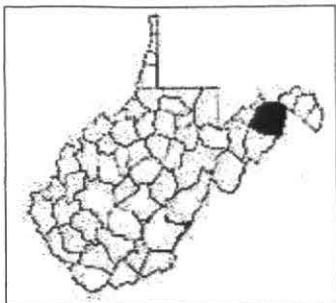

This house stands just southwest of the intersection of two county roads in north-central Hampshire County, west of Town Hill in the unincorporated village of Levels. Acres <u>none</u> Archaeological Artifacts Present

2-story vernacular I-house of wood construction, L-shaped in plan, with an intersecting gable roof, an interior corbel chimney on the main section and a gable-end chimney on the ell. The façade incorporates a 3-bay arrangement on the first story and 2 bays above, a design seen throughout this survey area. Extending across the façade is a hipped-roof porch supported by turned wood posts and trimmed with sawn brackets. A smaller scale side porch is on the north elevation, as is an enclosed rear/side porch. (Use Continuation Sheets)

The village of Levels was originally known as Levels Cross Roads because of its location at the intersection of four roads in north-central Hampshire County: Bright's Hollow Road (County Route 5/5) north to Okonoko, Little Cacapon-Levels Road (County Route 3/3) southeast to Slanesville, Jersey Mountain Road (County Route 5) south to Romney, and French's Station Road (County Route 5/7) northwest to South Branch Depot.
