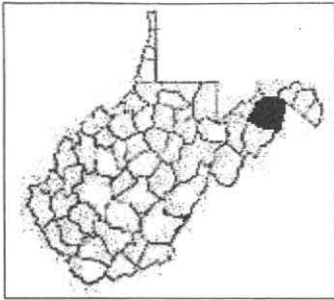

Deteriorated 2-story I-house of wood construction, with the façade incorporating a 3-bay arrangement on the first story and 2 bays above, a design seen elsewhere in this part of Hampshire County. The centered entrance on the façade is shielded by a pedimented hood which is supported by plain wood posts. The building appears vacant and deteriorated. Fenestration is flat topped, 2/2, without notable ornament.

Statement of Significance:											
The village of Levels was originally known as Levels Cross Roads because of its location at the intersection of four roads in north-central Hampshire County: Bright's Hollow Road (County Route 5/5) north to Okonoko, Little Cacapon-Levels Road (County Route 3/3) southeast to Slanesville, Jersey Mountain Road (County Route 5) south to Romney, and French's Station Road (County Route 5/7) northwest to South Branch Depot. This I-house represents early residential development in Levels but because of its deteriorated state it does not appear to meet National Register Criteria for Evaluation.
