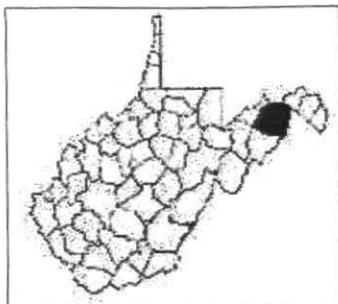

A 1-story wing is at the rear, with a shed-roof porch.
