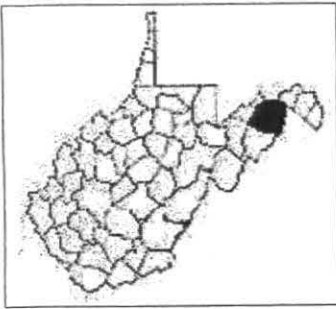

1½-story vernacular cottage with gable roof and gable-end-orientation to the street, with the ridge of the roof penetrated by a single red brick chimney. Façade incorporates a centered entrance, shielded by a hipped-roof porch which is supported by plain wood posts and is enclosed within a solid wood balustrade. Fenestration is flat topped, 3/1, set singly and in pairs. A 1-story addition is built on the rear elevation. The exterior surfaces are finished in multi-colored asphalt shingles.
