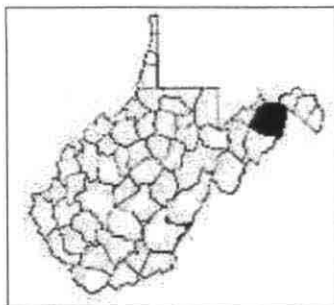

2-story vernacular residence of wood construction, with a side-gable roof and locally distinctive metal board-and-batten finish. Extending across the façade is a hipped-roof porch supported by plain wood posts. Paired entry doors access the building from the façade. Fenestration is flat topped, without notable ornament.
