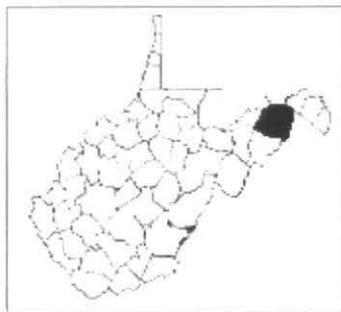
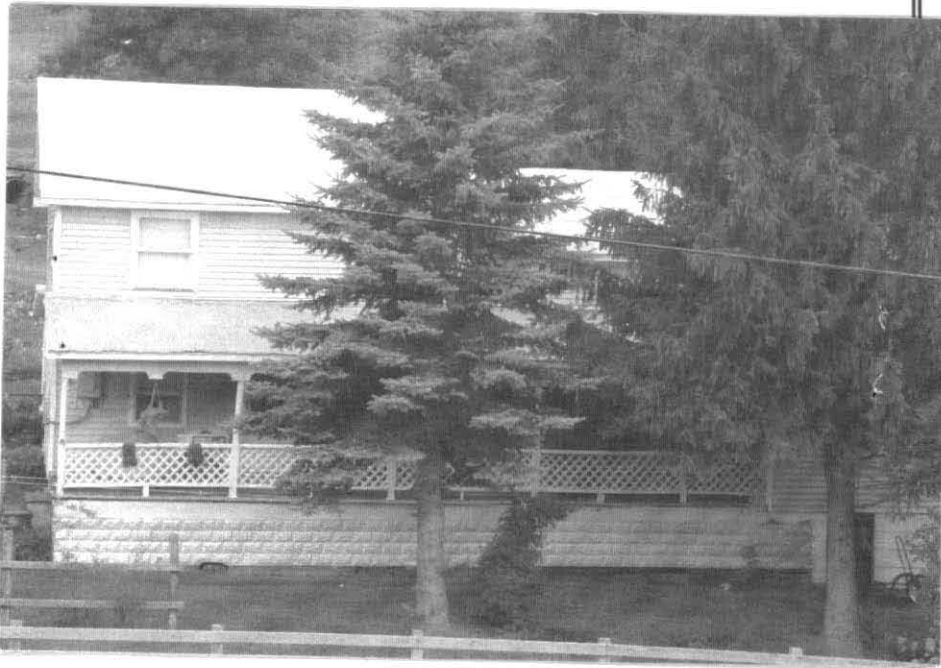

This property lies along a rural county road, northwest of the unincorporated village of Kirby and along the eastern foot of South Branch Mountain.

2-story vernacular residence of wood construction, whose profile suggests that it was built in stages. The taller of the two is massed suggesting that it may be of log construction. A shorter addition is built on to the gable-end, and the façade is tied together by means of a shed-roofed porch supported by wood posts and enclosed within a non-historic wood balustrade. The original porch skirting and portions of the foundation are clad in pressed metal simulating rock-faced stone. Fenestration is flat topped, 1/1.
