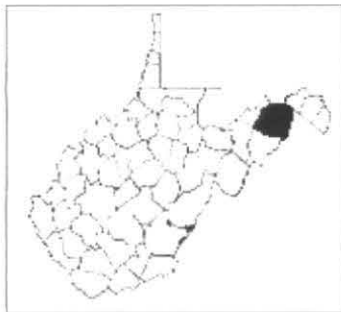

2 Stories 3 Front Bays

2-story vernacular residence of wood construction, with a side-gable roof and several gable-roofed additions at the rear of indeterminate age. Second story of the façade is two bays in width, and the first story is shielded by a shed-roofed porch wrapped in heavy plastic which precludes examination. Fenestration is flat-topped, without notable ornament, with 2/2, 1/1, and 6/6 sash. A modern open deck has been built on one gable end.
