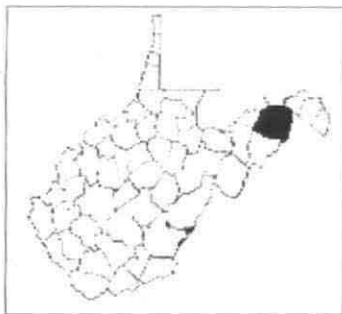

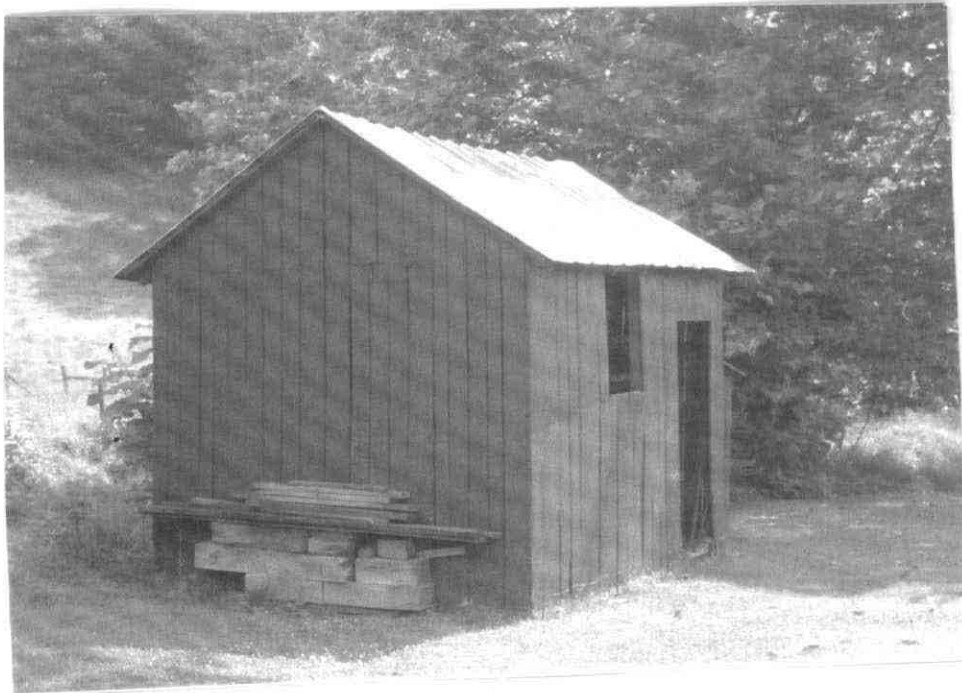

This property lies along a rural county road, south of the unincorporated village of Horn Camp, along the eastern foot of South Branch Mountain.

2 Stories 3 Front Bays	
2-story vernacular I-house of wood construction, with a side-gable roof and a rearward-projecting ell to which had been appended several additions. The façade incorporates a centered gable, and a 3-bay configuration on both the first and second story. A 1-bay shed-roofed porch shields the main entrance, supported by replacement wood posts. Fenestration is flat-topped, with 1/1 replacement sash without notable ornament.
